PRIVACY STATEMENT

In accordance with law D.LGS 196/03 Art. 13

In order to enter into a contract with you, Leonardo Sas di Capriotti Mara & C. will be in possession of your personal data.

1. These data will be used in paper and digital form. All data will be kept at Leonardo Sas di Capriotti Mara & C fully in compliance with all the current regulations.
2. Said data will be made available to fulfil contractual, legal and fiscal obligations.
3. Making data available as described in point 2 is compulsory and failure to do so will result in the termination of this contract.
4. It being understood that these data are conveyed to fulfil legal and contractual obligations, all data collected may be conveyed in Italy and abroad exclusively for the purposes described in point 2. Furthermore, all those permitted to use the data in accordance with the law will also have access to them. Leonardo Sas di Capriotti Mara & C will ensure that the above-mentioned third parties treat said data with utmost confidentiality and exclusively for the purposes stated.
5. All said data will also be kept after the termination of the contract for the fulfilment of any obligations connected to the termination of the contract itself.
6. The holder of the conveyed data is Capriotti Mara.
7. The legal address of the person in charge of said data is the company office itself. Therefore, you may contact this person for any information concerning the use of your personal data and law D.Lgs. 196/03, as well as a full and updated list of any other people in charge.
8. With regards to the data in the possession of Leonardo Sas di Capriotti Mara & C you may claim your rights as provided for by law D.Lgs. 196/03, of which a full copy is attached. In case of death, your heirs may claim your rights.

Law D.Lgs. 196/03

1. You have the right to know whether or not personal information about you is being held, even if not yet recorded, and to receive this information in an intelligible form.
2. You have the right to know:
where this information came from;
why and how this information is being used;
if the data is being used in digital form, the reason for doing so;
the identity of the holder, persons in charge, and the designated representative according to article 5, paragraph 2;
what persons or category of persons may receive your personal information or those that have access to it as designated representative on national territory or those in charge or appointed.
3. You have the right to obtain:
 - a. update, amend that is, when required, and integrate data;
 - b. cancel, transform in anonymous form, or block data used in violation of the law, including those that do not need to be kept for purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently used;
 - c. a declaration that the operations described in points a) and b) have been brought to the knowledge, also with regards to their content, of those to whom the data have been conveyed, except when it is impossible to do so or when doing so would clearly require means that are disproportionate to the right being defended.
4. You may oppose fully or partially:
 - a. the use of your personal data, even though pertinent to the aims of collection, for any legitimate reasons;
 - b. the use of your personal data for sending advertising material or direct selling or for carrying out market research or for commercial communication.
